## Aim of the Workshop:

The Ministry of the Environment of the Czech Republic requested to organise a TAIEX-EIR multi-country workshop on air quality within the Czech Presidency in the Council of the European Union to discuss future challenges in the air protection in Europe. The aim of the conference is to initiate a high level as well as expert level discussion regarding the possibilities to further improve the air quality and also to identify the remaining obstacles that are hindering the progress.

Given the fact that the air quality in the EU is significantly influenced by the transboundary air pollution, some representatives from countries outside the EU territory are also invited to join the discussion. The Workshop will therefore target experts from EU Member States as well as from Parties of the Convention on Long Range Transboundary Air Pollution (CLRTAP).
